



## **6 Days Spectacular Spain – Covering: Madrid, Valencia & Barcelona**

### **Day 1 London - Madrid**

Arrive at Madrid International Airport, and check in to the hotel to freshen up. Depart to Madrid, one of Europe's most vibrant cities. On arrival, take a panoramic tour of the Spanish capital to view the Royal Palace, Puerta del Sol, Cibeles Squares and Plaza Espana. For a taste of the real Spain we drive through the main streets and see the Neptune Fountain, Alcala Street and the world renowned, Gran Via. **D**

### **Day 2 Madrid**

Today visit Madrid's most emblematic and beautiful building the The Royal Palace, situated overlooking the river valley, its majestic architecture is astonishing and the lavishly decorated state rooms are truly to be admired, whilst being guided by an official guide. Later, view from outside the awe-inspiring Prado museum, housing one of the finest art collections in the world, be sure to walk along Paseo del Prado, a pedestrian walkway full of fountains and trees near the museum. After, proceed to the Gran Via to enjoy the sights and sounds of Madrid. Today you may wish to take an optional tour to Santiago Bernabéu the home ground of Real Madrid Football Club. This optional is not possible during event days. After dinner go on an optional night tour of Madrid, covering the iconic Metropolis building, Puerta del Sol, Palacio de Cibeles and the Royal Palace. **B, D**

### **Day 3 Madrid - Valencia**

Depart for Retiro Gardens known as the best gardens in Madrid. It occupies 120 hectares of land in the very centre of Madrid. Later drive to Valencia, located on Spain's eastern Mediterranean coast. Throughout history, Valencia was one of the most important seaports of the Iberian Peninsula. On arrival, depart for an excursion to L'Oceanogràfic, the largest aquarium in Europe which contains representatives of the world's main marine ecosystems. Each building is identified with the following aquatic environments: the Mediterranean, Wetlands, Temperate and Tropical Seas, Oceans, the Antarctic, the Arctic, Islands, and the Red Sea, as well as the Dolphinarium with 24 million litres of water and a depth of 10.5 metres. **B, D**

### **Day 4 Valencia - Barcelona**

Embark on a city tour of Valencia and enjoy picturesque views of the Town Hall, the Bull Ring, the massive Gateway Towers of Serranos and Quart. Today, witness one of the most prominent sights in Valencia, the La Seo Cathedral which houses numerous religious and artistic treasures. Later proceed to Barcelona for your evening meal followed by a rhythmic and captivating Flamenco performance to end your night.

Note: Flamenco Show may take place on day 5. **B, D**

### **Day 5 Barcelona - Costa Brava**

Today become familiar with Barcelona by taking a city tour with a local guide. Start by visiting the most popular gardens in Barcelona, known as Park Guell. Later view from outside the magnificence of Gaudi's controversial Sagrada Familia, the Plaza de Cataluna and Barcelona's Olympic Stadium. Today, enjoy the opportunity to stroll through the lively Ramblas, the city's most spirited street. Walk through the colourful flower stalls and markets to view the Christopher Columbus monument located near the waterfront. After lunch depart to visit the famous beach in Costa Brava known as Lloret de Mar. **B, L**

#### **Day 6** Barcelona - London

Check out and drive to the Montjuic for a breathtaking view of the city and harbour. Later enjoy free time at the Las Ramblas, a renowned promenade that is crowded during day and night. It is full of kiosks, florists, street performers, cafes, restaurants and shops. After proceed to the airport for your return flight.

Note: On occasions, due to large events, traffic, logistics and availability of reservations, it may be necessary to change the above itinerary. However all aspects of the itinerary will be covered.
